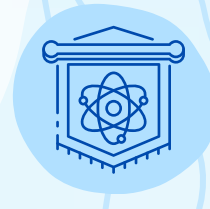

Building leaders through diplomacy, debate, and collaboration.



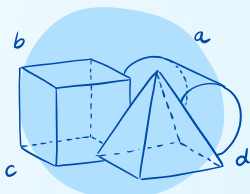
Literary Club

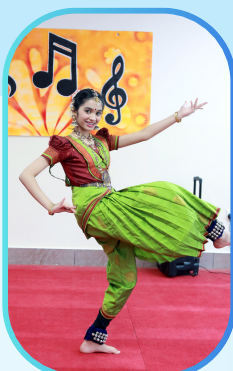
United by Art
